4 Advanced/Above Grade Level:

RIGHTHAND SIDE:

Notes are complete with extra information added that was NOT given by the teacher. It is **evident** that the student has been interacting/studying/amending their notes. (Examples: such as highlighting, drawings, annotations, etc.)

LEFTHAND MARGIN:

Includes multiple historical thinking questions. **Many** unknown words are listed and define. **Includes** student's comments/connections/communications that show an advanced level of student engagement and curiosity. (See historical thinking questions/Habits of Mind/etc.)

3 Proficient/At Grade Level:

RIGHTHAND SIDE:

Notes are complete with little extra information added that was NOT given by the teacher. It is **evident** that the student is interacting/studying/amending their notes. (Examples: see 4)

LEFTHAND MARGIN:

Includes at least 3 historical thinking questions per page. **Some** unknown words are listed and define.

Includes student's comments/connections/communications that show student engagement and curiosity. (Examples: see 4)

2 Basic/Near Grade Level:

RIGHTHAND SIDE:

Notes are complete with no extra information added. **Little** evidence to show that the student is interacting/studying/amending their notes.

LEFTHAND MARGIN:

Includes 1-2 historical thinking questions per page. **Few** unknown words are defined. **Few** comments/connections/communications are evident LOW student engagement and curiosity.
