At the **Geographer's Corner learning station**, students work on their interpretive skills while managing and analyzing geographic details, with the goal of building an in-depth geographic knowledge of the United States and the world. Students will use very precise language and vocabulary, while building historic, political, economic, physical, and thematic maps, along with legends/ keys that include user friendly icons and labels.
