

PROTOCOLS & EXPECTATIONS

JOURNALISM

1. Use Google Docs to type your final product.
2. Take notes and create your text structure maps in your notebook.
3. The tone of your writing should be very objective, even for the most emotionally charged topics.

ALL STATIONS:

1. Read, annotate, take notes, and have an initial answer to the guiding question in your mind.
2. Always Word Up! Show that you know!
3. When reading, don't skip words that you don't know. Stop and learn the word before moving on.
4. Volume at Independent stations is silent. Volume at collaborative stations is very low.
5. Use equipment and supplies with care and put everything back neatly when done.
6. Consult the rubrics and use the Stations Hub, because your goal is to perform all stations above grade level.
7. Consult the FORCE in all situations not addressed in these expectations and protocols.

ROUND TABLE

1. Treat the equipment with care; the microphone is not a toy.
2. Use discussion starters without making them sound forced or unnatural.

ART & DESIGN

1. Treat equipment and supplies with care.
2. Put supplies back neatly.
3. If you draw by hand, you must scan your drawing for upload to the GC.

GEOGRAPHY

1. Word Up! Word Up! Word Up!

TEXPLORER

1. Try new techniques and programs.
2. Cyberspace eats time, so watch the clock!

MOVIE MAGIC

1. Treat the people whom you portray with respect. Humor is fine, but making fun is not.
2. Your goal is to get your final product to look very close to a semi-professional movie trailer.
