

Class instructions:

1st: Finish making your vocabulary PERSONAL dictionary, in your notebook.

1. Vocabulary list link is on my digital agenda, under **Station #1: Theme #2 Vocabulary**
2. Include:
 - word
 - definition
 - synonym
 - and a picture

2nd: Annotate the reading about the Homestead Act

1. Circle key words
2. Underline and define, or find synonyms for, the words you do NOT know and write them above the word. You can also write them in the margins and draw a line from the definition or synonym to the word in the text.
3. Summarize each paragraph
4. Reread for understanding.
5. Answer the questions.
